VanLoo says landscaping lights cost less than \$10 a month in electricity. The only required maintenance is cleaning the lenses of the light fixtures once a year.

Second home owners at the Lake of the Ozarks can't always be on-site to supervise home improvements. VanLoo says he is able to accommodate out-of-town clients through phone and email. He doesn't need access to the inside of the home as long as there is electricity outside.

"We do our best to make the process as seamless as possible," says VanLoo. "There will be minimal



disturbance to your yard and existing landscaping while we are installing the lighting system."
